

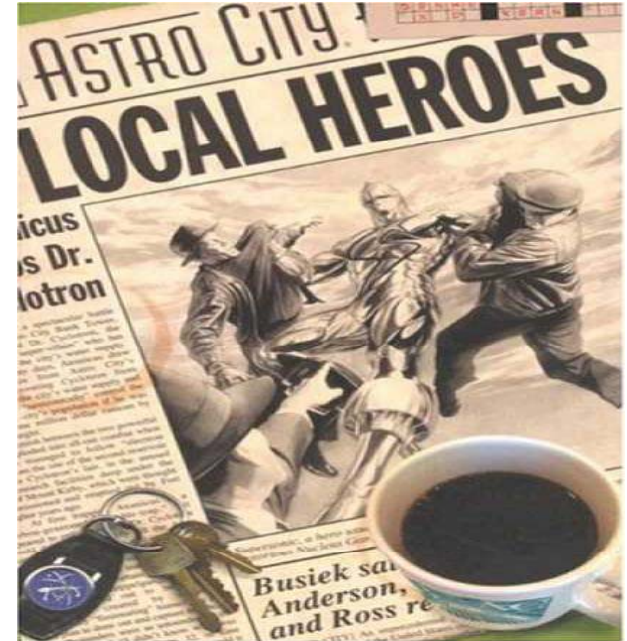
Do you want to be a Water Champion?”

- Builds capacity for secondary school organizations to inform the community about the importance of water conservation and the existence of cost saving/water reducing technologies.
- Recruit s regional/local retailers of water- consuming technologies to participate in EPA’s WaterSense program.
- Gathers data on the purchase of water efficient technologies and calculates the reduced volume of water used and cost savings associated with these purchases.
- Shares project outcomes and looks to recruit additional organizations in the area to participate in this service-learning project
